- Create a European Rowing digital community to:
  - promote competition and training opportunities for clubs
  - share best practice
  - share information about funding opportunities

## 2. Events & Competition

- Provide competitive and compelling racing that promotes the sport globally and sustainably:
  - Ensure competitive racing opportunities at ER championships
  - Work with WR & MFs to create a cohesive calendar of events that promotes rowing
  - Attract competitive bids for ER championships
  - Review mandatory requirements for ER championships
  - Explore further multi-sport opportunities for all ER championships disciplines
- Innovate and evolve to stay relevant & attract fans: festivaliastion

### 3. Development

- Create performance pathways to encourage participation
- Highlight opportunities for MFs to collaborate to develop disciplines:
  - Para Rowing
  - Indoor Rowing
  - Coastal Rowing
- Grow number of female participants
- Review and encourage participation of Masters Rowing at ER events.

- Improve sustainability initiatives at ER championships
  - water & water bottles
  - travel and transfers
  - Accommodation
  - waste
- Promote best practice in clean water management
  - Engagement with WWF
  - Use events as a platform to share learning
